- Measure, mark, and align work areas using chalk lines, plumb bobs, levels, and squares for precision.
- Cut, shape, and smooth construction materials using hand or power tools.
- Estimate quantities of cement, sand, and aggregates accurately to minimize waste.

#### Quality, Safety & Compliance (QHSE)

- Ensure all masonry work meets structural and aesthetic quality standards as per company specifications.
- Adhere to Quality, Health, Safety, and Environment (QHSE) policies, including use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and compliance with factory safety rules.
- Maintain cleanliness and order at workstations in line with 5S principles: Sort, Set in Order, Shine,
  Standardise, and Sustain.
- Handle tools, equipment, and materials safely to prevent injury or property damage.
- Report unsafe acts, near misses, or incidents immediately to the supervisor.
- Support compliance with ISO 9001 (Quality Management) and ISO 14001 (Environmental Management) standards.
